Olivié Keck (b.1989, Cape Town) received a BA(FA) in Printmaking from Michaelis School of Fine Art, University of Cape Town in 2011 and has since shown in numerous group exhibitions in Cape Town. Working with a variety of techniques and forms such as delicate ink paper tapestries, large-scale quilts, printmaking and embroidery, and with a narrative and process driven approach, Keck ventures to decipher the transient natural world and her place within it.
